



MIGRATORY BIRD PROTECTION

Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA)

Enacted 1918 • 16 U.S.C. §§ 703–712

RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT 1 MARCH THROUGH 15 SEPTEMBER OR ANY ACTIVE BIRD NESTS

DO

- Check your area before digging, driving, or setting up
 - Stop work if a nest, eggs, or chicks are found
 - Mark the area Report immediately
-

DO NOT

- Do not touch birds, do not disturb active nests, do not handle eggs or chicks
 - Do not pick up feathers, do not remove nests from buildings or structures
-

CONSEQUENCES

INDIVIDUAL

- Federal citation
- Up to \$15,000 fine (per violation), Up to 6 months confinement, Adverse administrative action

UNIT

- Command notification
 - Mandatory retraining
